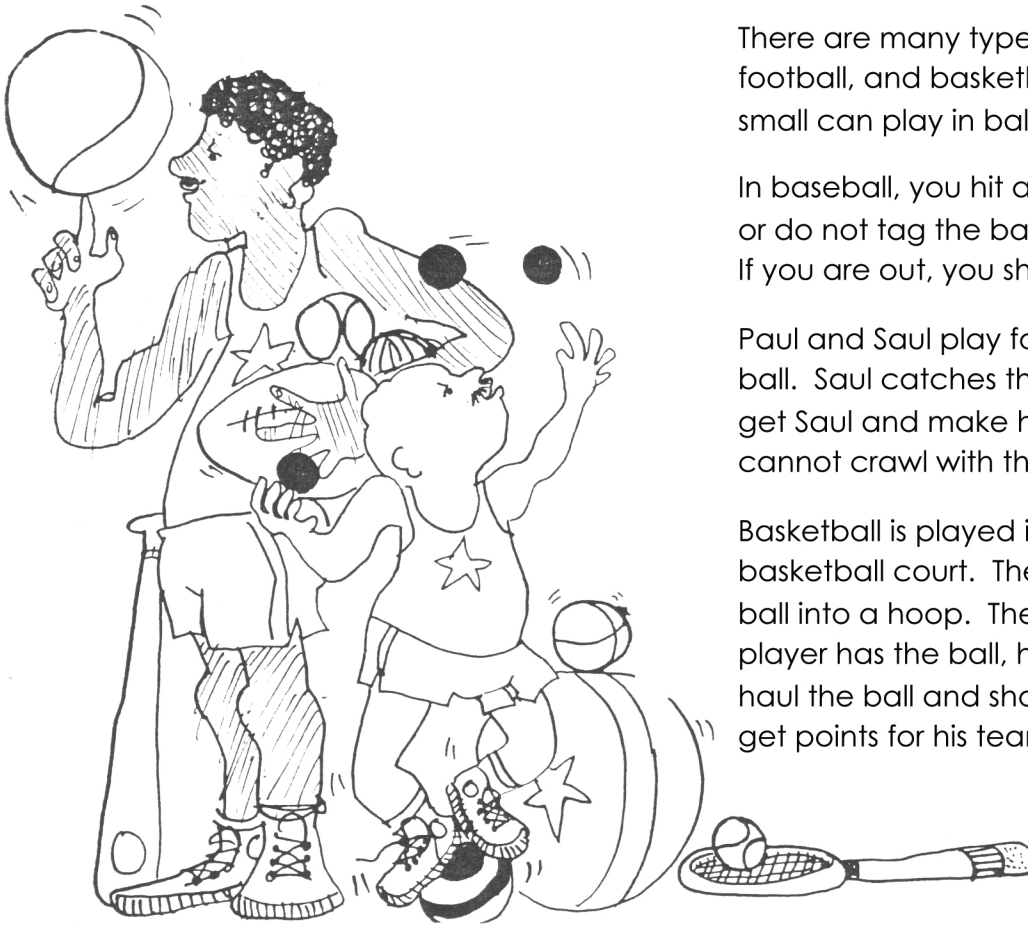


Ball Games

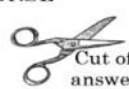
