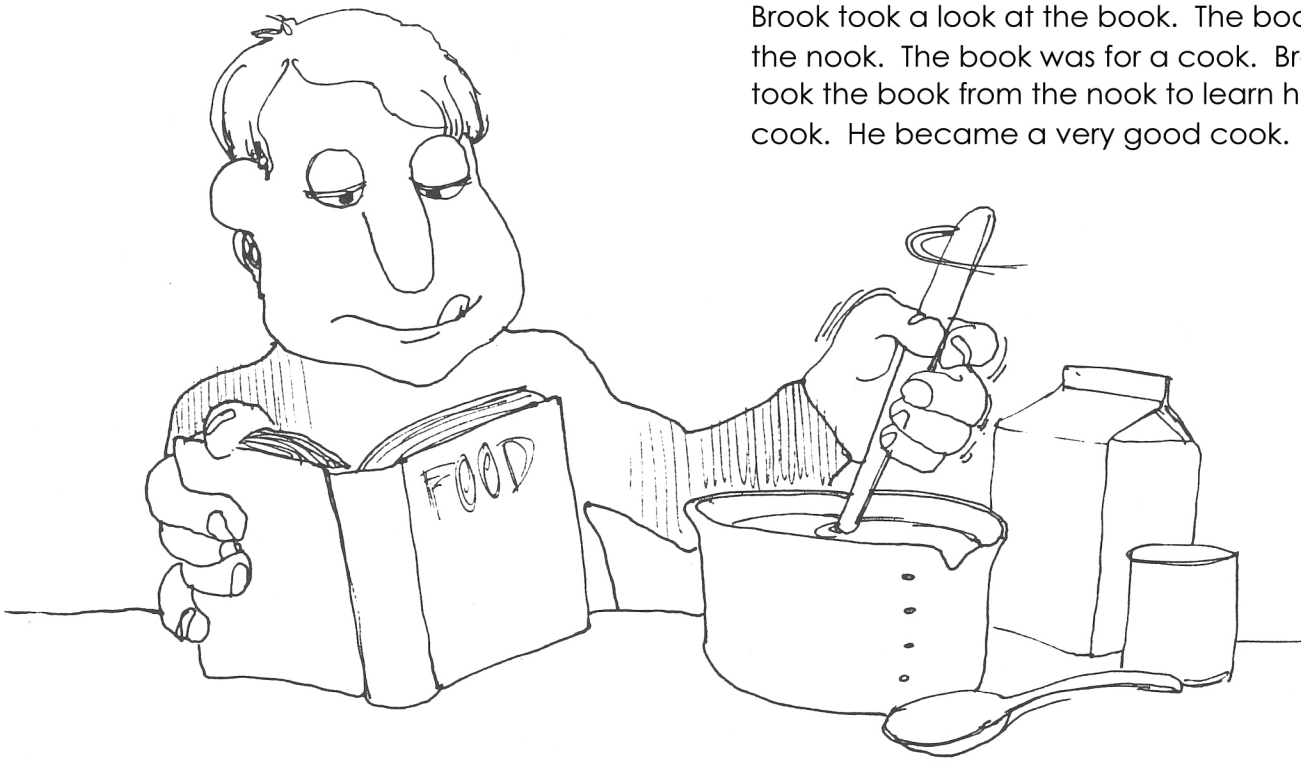

Brook took a look at the book. The book was in the nook. The book was for a cook. Brook took the book from the nook to learn how to cook. He became a very good cook.

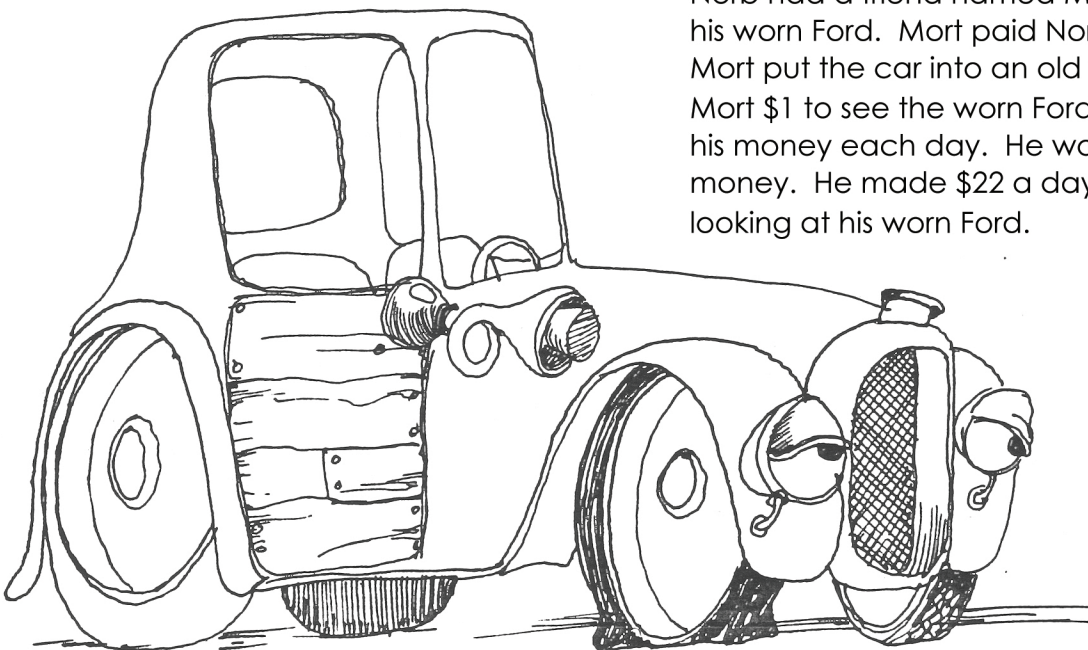

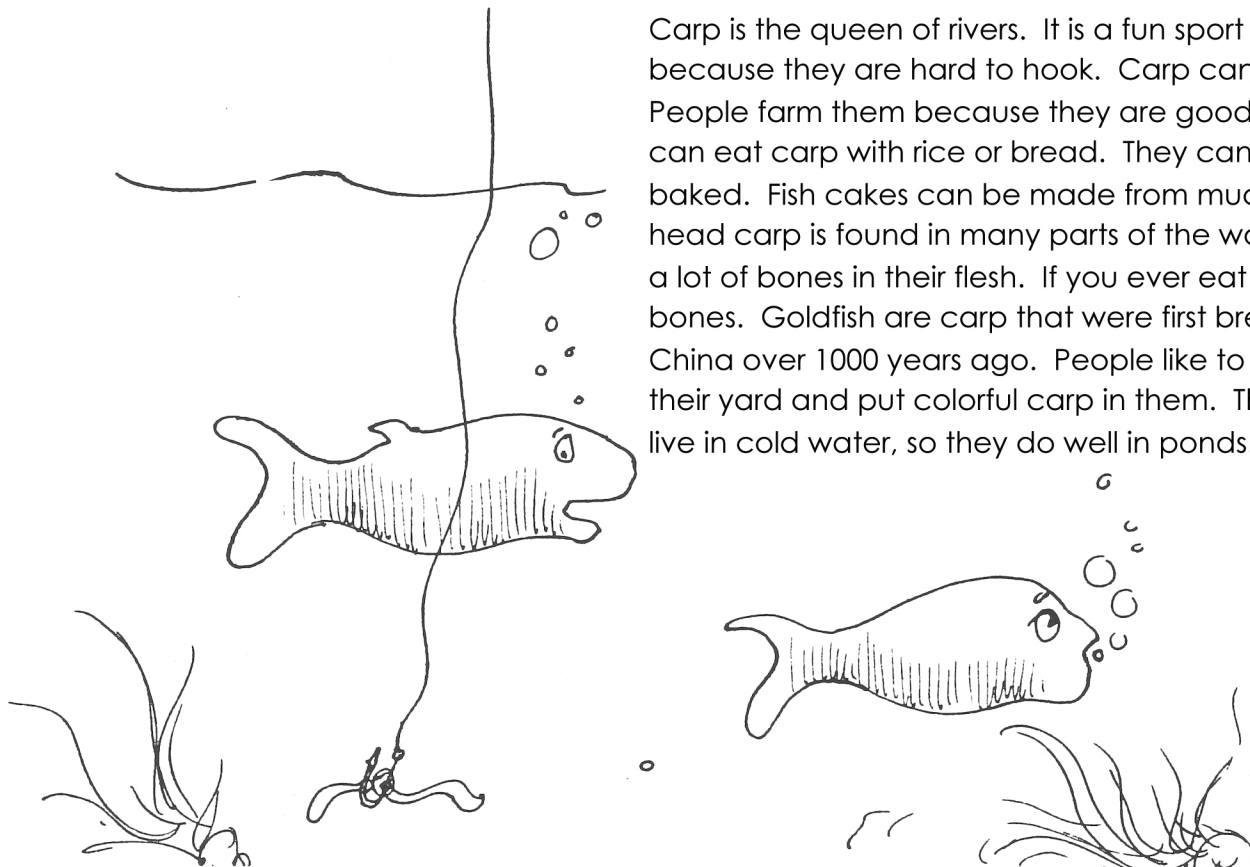
Carl tried many times to get the car out of the tar. When he did get the car out of the tar, he took it back to his farm. He would not take the car to the big city ever again.

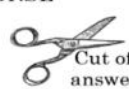
