"Shells!" said the sheep.

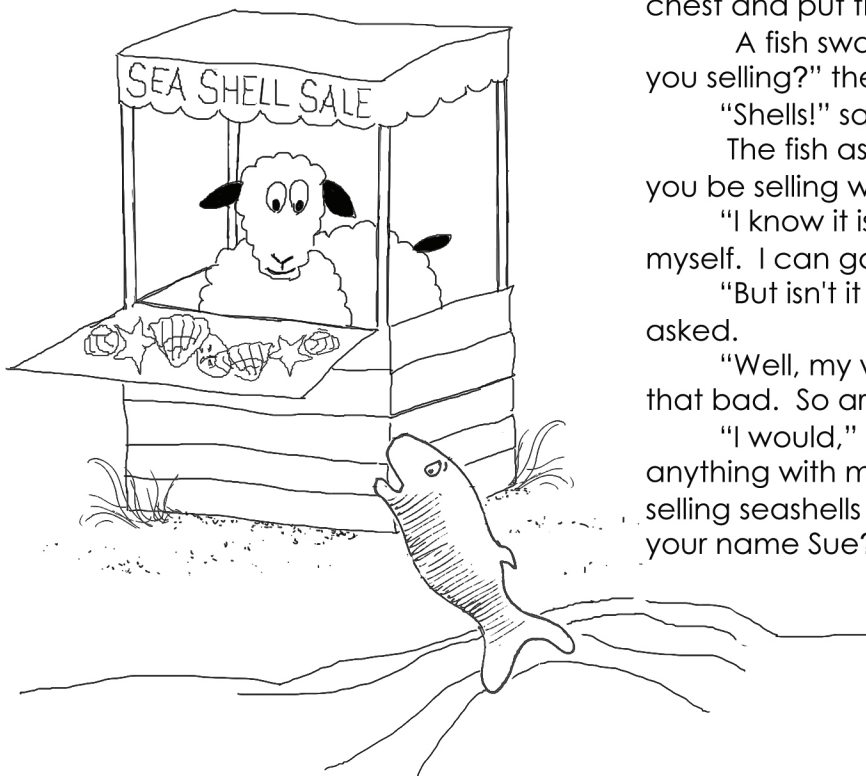
The fish asked, "Why shells? You're a sheep. Shouldn't you be selling wool?"

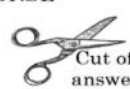
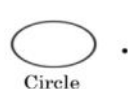
